Matters Arising	<ul> <li>As Brian McDonald is not present it was decided to put ATV vehicles on the agenda for the next meeting</li> <li>Councillor Anne Skene wrote to Andy Duff, Senior Traffic Engineer re the pedestrian crossing in Market Street, his reply was it is not possible and it is unlikely that the criteria for a controlled crossing can be met. Road traffic counts are to be taken. John Bremner is to share this information with the Community Council.</li> <li>A trial run of the Footprint leaflets has been undertaken.</li> <li>Forres in Bloom judging takes place on Saturday 6<sup>th</sup> October – follow up at next meeting.</li> <li>Moray Fair Trade Forum – Lorna Cresswell attended the forum and there does not look to be a lot of work needed, such as some restaurant and cafes selling fair trade items. Lorna has spoken to Meg McKenzie who feels it would be ok could get back to churches, by the end of the year the government want the country to be Fair Trade. Councillor Lorna Cresswell thought that perhaps Forres should be called a Co-operative Town, Elgin has mostly been running with this so far. Have to pass a resolution for fair trade. A local steering group has yet to be convened. Alan MacBeth is the point of contact and will create a website, if the information is given to him he will put Forres on a fair-trade map, the next meeting is to be held on 4<sup>th</sup> December 2012. Liz Stewart from Forres Academy will be promoting this. The Forres Area Forum is happy for Forres to be a Fair Trade Town and John Bremner is to take this idea up to the Community Council. Valerie Wardlaw – Chinese New Year	Valerie Wardlaw is looking to fund another year of celebrations to coincide with Chinese New Year as last years celebrations were a great success. Valerie is working with the Shen Foundation and believes that this is an exciting opportunity to	

	match up micro businesses within the area and make links with Chinese organisations abroad and in the UK. This will happen on Sunday 17 <sup>th</sup> February 2013. FAF would be of help to Valerie by writing a letter of support and Valerie said that she would be applying for a grant to David Watson at Leader of around £4,000 and a grant of £200 from the FAF. It was suggested that perhaps Forres could twin with a small area within China, this would have to be looked in to. Those present were supportive of this project.	
Moray Towns Partnership (MTP)	Sandra Maclennan received an email from Alan MacBeth who hopes to have the list from each town by December and would need the FAF draft by the beginning of December. Fabio Villani is to redraft an article for the Forres Gazette and check with Tanya to see if it is possible to publish it. Sandra, Fabio and Aaron are to work on the existing draft 3-year plan, involving Kresanna Aigner and any member of the public interested in participating, in order to prioritise a list. The resulting list, Forres 3-year action plan, is to be circulated before the November meeting and those present should have read it by the next meeting. Allotments	There was an Allotment Seminar on 25 <sup>th</sup> September 2012 in the Elgin library, around 20 persons turned up. The Allotment Policy for Moray Council is 2 years old and is up for revision. Carin who attended the seminar stated that 4 years ago there was a small private allotment in Burghead and that was it in Moray. In Forres there is a community garden and there is an allotment in Cullen on private land and a garden share in Elgin. After 2 years there are still no Council run allotments in Moray. Presentations took place and facilitators took down information from those present as to what they would like to see happen in the future. There was a presentation from Highland and Island Council. Their planning regulations now state that all new housing developments must have land for allotments, 1 sq m per person, with a current suggestion of increasing this up to 4 sq m per person of land which is to be set aside for allotments within the centre of any such new development. Councillor Aaron McLean attended and he noted that Richard Hartland was present and he was quite positive about this subject.
